**Blocking features:** Sites can be added to a blacklist and a timer set to block access to them. It is also possible to enable certain subpages of Web sites while blocking the rest of them and there is a 'nuclear' option which cannot be reversed for 24 hours.

**Extra features:** Setting up the "Require Challenge" option gives you a small challenge to complete before you are allowed to change any of the settings you have chosen.
